Before the Meeting

Consider what readings, songs, scriptures, and people you would like included in your ceremony. Bring that information to your meeting even if you don't plan on using them in the ceremony. This gives Rev. McKnight the opportunity to more fully understand the language you value in naming your feelings toward one another. It also allows her to craft a service that is both meaningful and individualized to you and your partner.

Counseling

Urban Abbey does not require counseling. We do encourage couples to participate in counseling with a trained and certified therapist for three to five sessions to explore communication, financial plans, family planning, and healthy conflict resolution.
